## ST. ROCK



### PATRON OF OUR SCHOOL

St. Rock was born in France around 1295 A.D. His father was the Governor of Montpellier. He was left orphan at the age of 20, after which he gave up his wealth and power and left for Rome on a pilgrimage.

On his way he found many parts of Italy being struck with plague and he devoted himself to cure the people.

Finally, he himself was stricken with plague and the wounds appeared on his thigh. Not wishing to be a burden to anyone, he dragged himself out into the deep woods to die but was saved by a dog which fed him bread daily. When he was cured from the disease he continued to help the sick. Later he returned to Montpellier where he was mistaken for a spy and was imprisoned. He remained in prison for five years till his death.

At the Council of Constance held between 1414-1418 A.D. he was declared a Saint because by his intercession a local epidemic had stopped. From then on St. Rock is venerated respectfully. His Feast is celebrated on the 16th of August every year.

## ST. ANNE

### PATRONESS OF OUR CONGREGATION



St. Anne is the Patroness of our Congregation. The name 'Anne' means 'GRACE'. Tradition refers to St. Anne as being the Mother of Virgin Mary, Mother of Jesus.

Anne was born in Bethlehem and was married to Joachim from Nazareth in Galilee. Even after twenty years of marriage the couple had no children. So Joachim went into a desert to plead with God to bless them with a child. He spent a long time in fasting and prayer in the desert. Finally, God heard

the prayers of Joachim and Anne and blessed them with a girl child. God asked them to name her 'Mary' and dedicate her to His service.

After the child was born, Joachim and Anne named her 'Mary' and dedicated her to God. The child Mary spent much of her childhood at the temple of Jerusalem. When Mary was fourteen years old, she was betrothed to Joseph of Nazareth. And so Mary's story continues with the birth of her son Jesus and His life on earth.

The life of St. Anne and her connection as Holy Mother of Mary and Grandmother of Jesus has been very popular among all the Christians in the world.

The Feast of St. Anne and St. Joachim is celebrated every year on the 26th of July. St. Anne is honoured as the Patron Saint for Education. She is also honoured as the Patron Saint of Mothers, Women and Girl Children. There are numerous educational institutions in her name run by various societies and organizations which includes our own St. Anne's Congregation.

## MOTHER GNANAMMA

### OUR FOUNDRRESS SERVANT OF GOD



The Society of Sisters of St. Anne is a Pontifical Congregation. It was chiefly founded for the empowerment of the powerless, especially women and girls. The vision of the Congregation springs from the life and work of the Foundress Thattipathi Gnanamma. In the 1860's she sensed the inner longing of the girls for liberation in Kilacheri village, near Chennai, in the state of Tamil Nadu, India. The sensitivity to the cry of the poor and creative response to the signs of the times define the core identity of the Congregation.

This drives the Sisters of St. Anne-Chennai to engage themselves in liberative, empowering and life-giving mission for the marginalized. In 1979, on 6th December the Congregation was elevated to the Pontifical Status by Pope John Paul II. The Generalate is located at Madhavaram in Chennai. The Congregation is divided into three province and two regions.

The sisters involve in various ministries - social, spiritual, cultural, pastoral, medical, educational - that manifest in concrete actions the word of God and teachings of the Roman Catholic Church.

### NOTE TO PARENTS AND STUDENTS

- The school day begins with an assembly. All the students must be present when the bell rings for the assembly.
- Students are reminded to greet their teachers and all the members of the staff with due respect.
- ID cards and student's handbooks are issued to all students. Every student should have them with her from the time she leaves home for school until she reaches back home.
- Parents are requested to see that their wards maintain proper health and hygiene. All the students must come to school in neat, clean and well-ironed uniforms.
- To acquire fluency in English language, only English should be spoken in the school premises or else, the students are liable to be fined.

- Any communication made by the parent should be addressed to the Principal and not to the class teacher.
- Parents are requested not to enter any class room to see their children without the permission from the principal.
- No student shall be promoted to the next higher class if she fails to obtain pass marks in all the subjects. A deficiency of attendance for more than 30 days will also disqualify the student for promotion. No arrangement will be made for holding special examinations for absentees before or after the time fixed for the examination.
- Parents and guardians are requested to cooperate with the school authorities by enforcing discipline and regularity at home and see that their wards attend school regularly.
- Parents and guardians are expected to scrutinize progress reports issued periodically to their wards and encourage to rectify the short comings in their studies.
- Parents and guardians may consult the Principal at least once a term to enquire about the conduct and progress of their wards.
- Parents and guardians are requested to make the full payment of the annual school fees without fail at the time of obtaining results of your wards after the annual examinations. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- No leave of absence is granted to the student except for serious reasons. Previous written application from the parents or guardians is compulsory for availing leave by the students.

- Any damage done to school property by the students must be compensated by the parents.
- Late comers will be fined in order to maintain the highest standard of discipline and decorum of the institution.
- In the school premises, no student is permitted to possess mobile phones or any other electronic gadgets. If any student is found with these gadgets the same will be confiscated by the institution.
- Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, neglect of homework, disrespect and disobedience by students or parents towards teachers and members of the school may entail either suspension or dismissal of the student from the school.
- Any grievance by students and parents or guardians should be brought to the Principal in person only.
- Students excelling in studies/games/competitions will be awarded annually. Due recognition will also be given for exemplary character, behaviour, conduct and human values.
